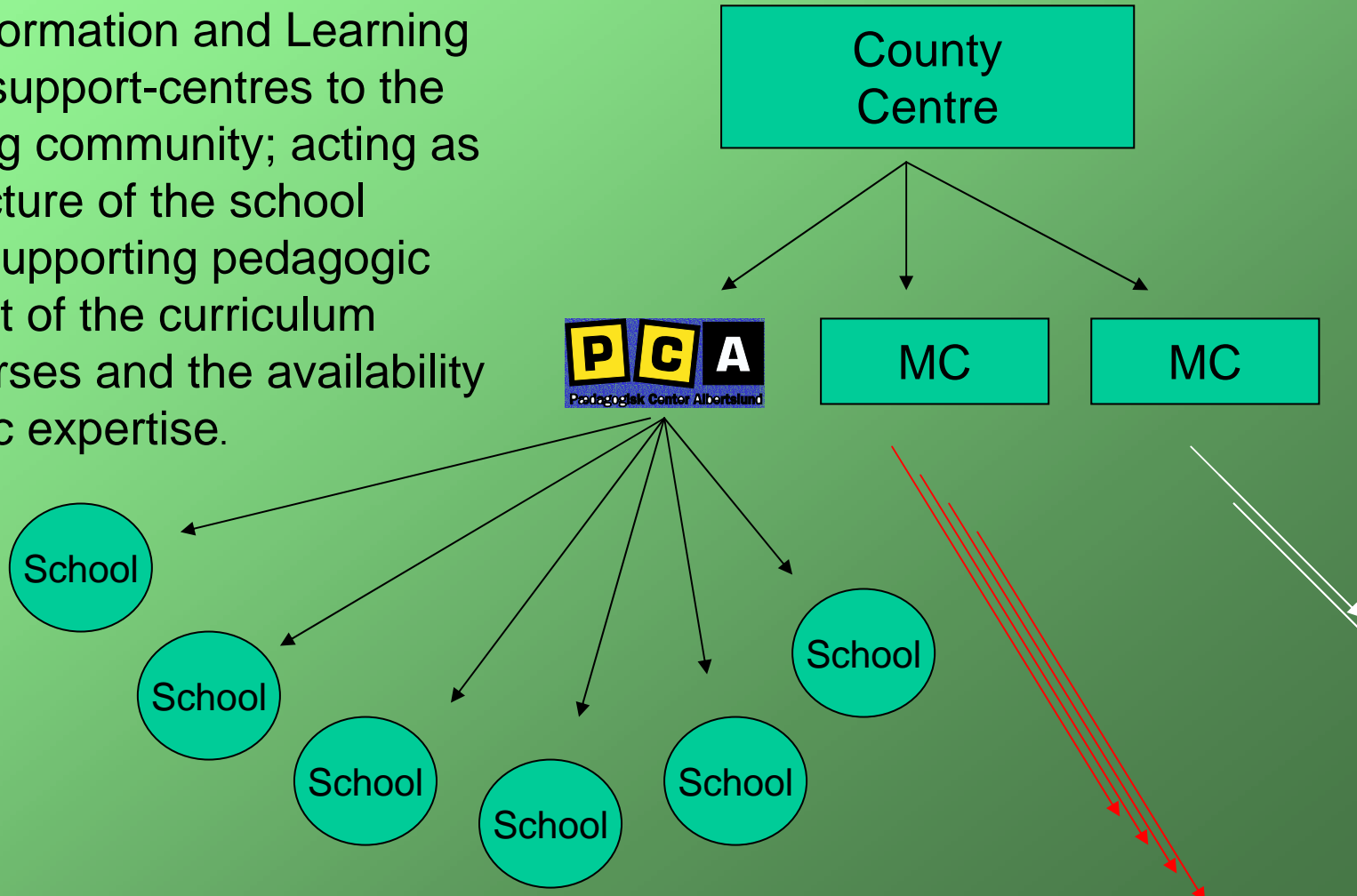

Regional Information and Learning Centres

Regional Information and Learning Centres as support-centres to the local learning community; acting as a superstructure of the school library and supporting pedagogic development of the curriculum through courses and the availability of pedagogic expertise.



Pedagogical Guidance

- The centre provides support to the schools by making pedagogic expertise available.

Pedagogic personnel and advisers are attached to the centre.



In service training

The centre provides an extensive number of courses for teachers from the community schools

The centre has own classrooms with modern equipment and an ICT classroom



Learning materials

Collections of materials, in print, CD-rom, audio- and videotapes and as computer programmes, which are available on the market for use in the school

New-ideas materials, reports about educational developmental projects, pedagogical/ psychological literature.



Advisors with knowledge of learning materials and teaching methods will assist teachers in finding and obtaining materials and relevant literature.

Library service

The centre have made arrangements with suppliers of all kinds of teaching/learning materials and equipment.

Therefore they are able to offer the schools large discounts on prices, fast delivery and the best equipment available.



Collections on learning materials



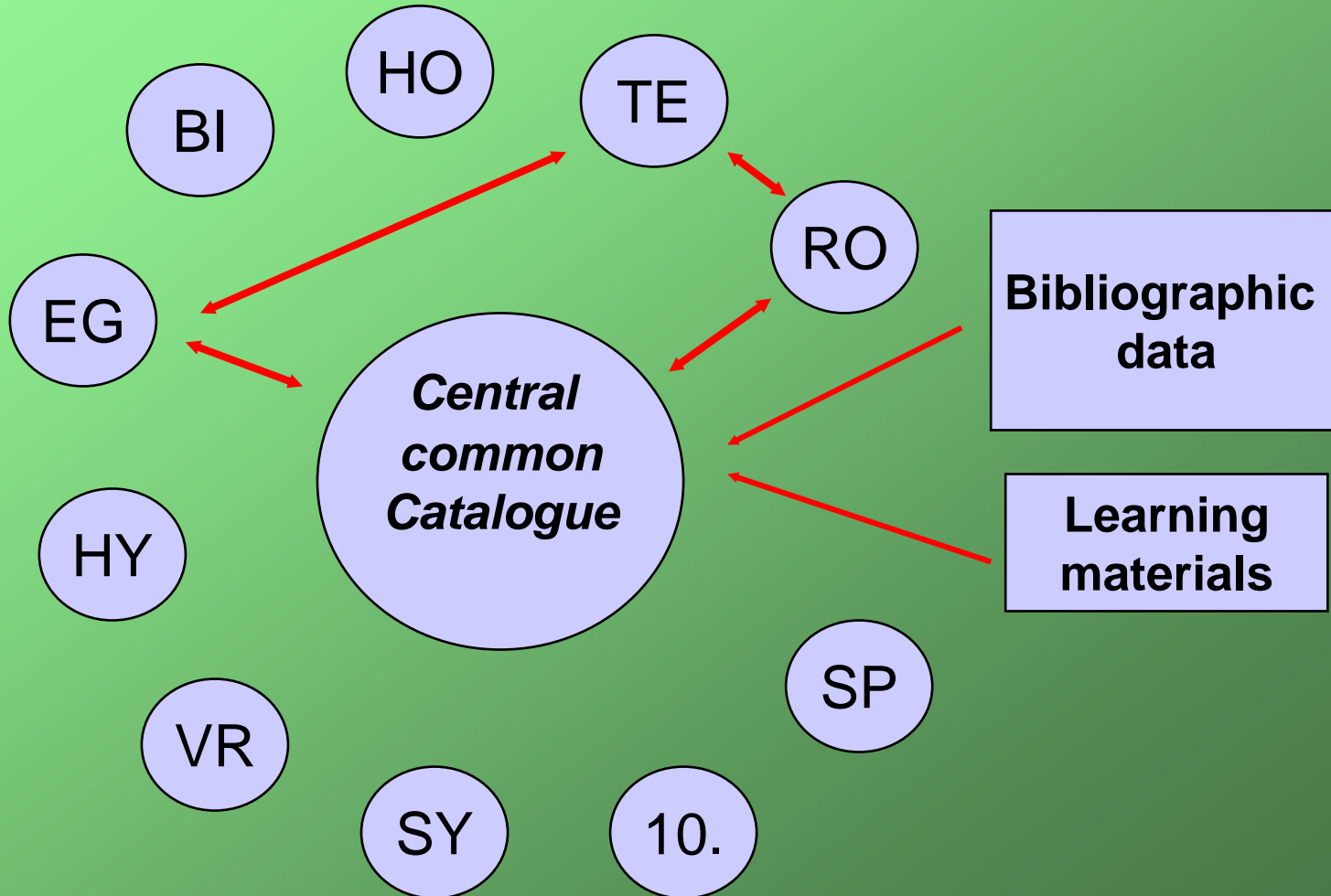
As a supplement to the school libraries the Centre lends out sets of books, AV materials, films, video and TV programmes and computer programmes.

By-lingual materials and educational toys are also available
